## **REPORT CONTROLLED BURNS:**

Call 1(866)404-4911 **Before AND After** Your Controlled Burn.

Information that is required:

Your name, contact number, land location, etc. Be sure you or your tenant have firefighting on your insurance policy to cover property, building, land etc. as callout fees begin at \$980.45 per hour.

# **DITCH MOWING:**

Plan on mowing your own ditch? Please submit maps to the RM office prior to **June 15th, 2022** indicating which ditches you will be mowing. Thank you!

## **PEST CONTROL:**

Our pest control supplies is located at the RM shop, please call the office in advance so that we can arrange pickup.

## **BUILDING DEVELOPMENT PERMITS**

Permits are required for development within the RM boundaries. The Construction Codes Act came into effect January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, which provides legislative framework for the application of construction codes and enforcement of construction standards, PBI Inc. has been appointed as the building inspectors for the Municipality. All new buildings are required to comply with the Codes and owners of an existing farm house are required to comply with the Codes for any work which begins after January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022. Farm buildings without sleeping quarters used for an agricultural purpose such as housing of livestock, production, storage or maintenance with an agricultural operation may be exempt, though a development permit is still required. Development Permits, Residential, Commercial permits as well as Farm Building Exemption Request Form is available at the RM office.

Please contact the office prior to any building, development or subdivision plans.

# **CARBON MONOXIDE AND SMOKE ALARMS: (ACTION REQUIRED!)**

\*\* In compliance with *The Construction Codes Act, Regulations* and the *National Building Code* 2015 (NBC 2015), as of **July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022**, all buildings in Saskatchewan with sleeping rooms, regardless of the date the building was constructed, are required to provide early warning protection against the effects of carbon monoxide (CO) poisoning, smoke and fire.

## MIDALE/CYMRI FIRE & RESCUE: NEW FIRE HALL UPATE!

<u>COMMUNITY WATER WELL:</u> This well is a good source of non-potable water and available for everyone in our communities of the RM of Cymri, located South of Macoun, at SE 15-04-10W2M.

<u>RM SETBACKS</u>: All buildings, dwellings, structures & trees are required to be set back a minimum of **150 feet** from the center of any municipal road allowance and **300 feet** from any intersection.

## **UPDATED 2022: DUST CONTROL**

Dust control services to a maximum of 200 meters will be provided to ratepayers upon request of the ratepayer and approval of Council, anything over the 200 meters requested by the ratepayer will be supplied at the full cost to the ratepayer. ## **MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS**

Election Day is *November 9<sup>th</sup>*, *2022*. Call for nominations for *Divisions 2*, *4 and 6* will be advertised on September 19<sup>th</sup> in the local newspapers and will be received in the Municipal Office at 234 Main Street in Midale during the nomination period from 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. on October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

#### **WESTPHALIA CEMETERY:**

Sandra Carlson continues to keep the cemetery looking neat and tidy! We request the limitation of objects placed in your family plots, and ask that glass items not be used. NOTE: Please contact either the RM or the Town of Midale office *prior* to working in the cemetery.

## **GRAIN BAG RECYCLING PROGRAM:**

The Upper Souris Watershed Assoc. has two grain bag rollers available for use, and two collection sites to dispose of rolled grain bags. **Grain bags must be rolled. No loose twine, plastic, or net wrap is allowed. Midale (NE 28-5-12 W2)** 6 miles west on the 606; 1.6 miles north on RGE Rd 2123.

## **SNOW REMOVAL FROM DRIVEWAYS:**

Pushing and clearing snow from private driveways across or onto the municipal right-of—way is not permitted. This practice causes frozen ridges, excess drifting and is a **very serious safety concern. Please do not push snow onto the roadway** or it may be cleared at your cost.
